Our bespoke face-to-face training workshops add a practical element to oral health training and can take place within in your workplace.

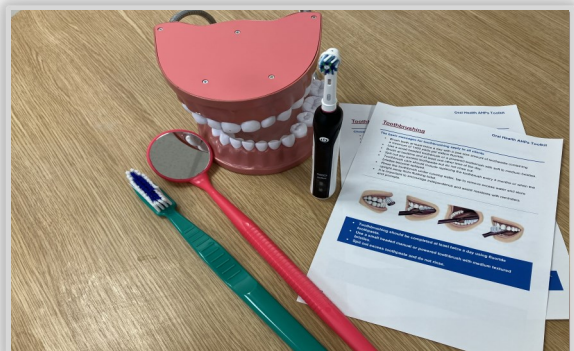
